Down on the Farm (Age 5—12 yrs old)

During the week, campers explore our animals, gardens and fields through a variety of activities, games and crafts. It is an ideal week for those who enjoy getting their hands in the dirt! Highlight: caring for your own “adopted” animal”. The week culminates as families join campers for a parade of animals which they have worked with during the week. Note: each session offers different activities.

Farm Extravaganza (Ages 11-13 yr olds)

Farm extravaganza is for the camper seeking an in depth farming experience. Campers participate in an assortment of farm and forest projects which teach them about sustainable farming practices and approaches to local ecosystems. The week incorporates team building and leadership activities and campers gain a sense of accomplishment and self-esteem. Highlight: optional overnight on Thursday.

Farm Explorer (Ages 14-16 yr olds)

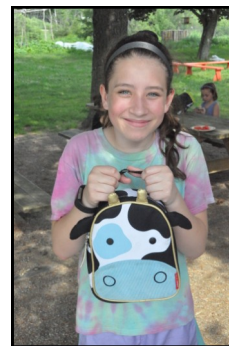
